This selection opens with the scene at the ball after Alfredo has insulted Violetta, whose friends sing "Shame on the cruelty thy lips have spoken." Then Violetta, left alone, sings (Cornet solo) "Ah, was it him my heart foretold." Following incidental music, Alfredo's father pleads with his son to return home (Euphonium solo), "Hath thy home in fair Provence from thy heart then passed away?" After the chorus "Away where joy invites ye" comes the duet of Alfredo and Violetta following their reconciliation (Cornet and Trombone), "Far from the busy throng thou wilt guide me." Finale from the masked ball scene.
